

**MINUTES OF SPECIAL CITY COMMISSION MEETING
MADISON, FLORIDA
AUGUST 22, 2017**

The City Commission met in a special meeting at 5:30 p.m. in City Hall. Mayor/Commissioner Rayne Cooks (District 1), Commissioner Ina Thompson (District 2), Commissioner Jim Catron (District 3), Commissioner Jim Stanley (District 4), and Commissioner Judy Townsend (District 5) were present.

City staff present were: Tim Bennett-City Manager, Lee Anne Hall-City Clerk, George T. Reeves-Acting City Attorney, David Floyd-Public Work Superintendent, and Michael Dupree-Public Works Department.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and stated the purpose of the special meeting was to conduct an appeal hearing, as requested by city employee Michael Dupree, concerning a disciplinary matter.

Commissioner Townsend moved to adopt the agenda; seconded by Commissioner Thompson. Motion passed 5-0.

Commissioner Stanley moved to uphold the Public Works superintendent's written disciplinary warning against Public Works employee Michael Dupree regarding Mr. Dupree's job performance. The disciplinary warning will remain in Mr. Dupree's personnel file for six months and if no further issues arise regarding Mr. Dupree's job performance, the warning will then be removed from his personnel file. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Catron and passed 5-0.

Commissioner Stanley moved to adjourn; seconded by Commissioner Catron. Motion passed 5-0. The meeting adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
