- Performs routine first echelon maintenance to the equipment
- May be temporarily assigned to operate in support of any of the public works and utilities department projects.

Education and Experience:

- High school diploma or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma accepted by the local community college.
- 2 years' experience in the operation and routine maintenance of the type of equipment of primary assignment.

License/Certification or Registrations:

Class "B" CDL Driver License to operate larger trucks (dump trucks, bucket truck or knuckle boom.)
